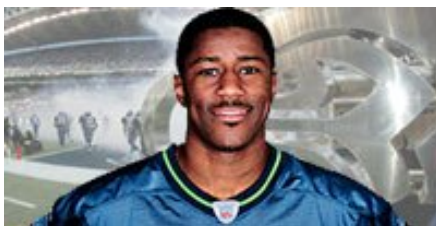
Thank you for renewing your membership

Most Improved player of 2007/8 season



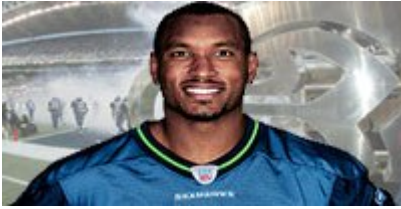
Nate Burleson

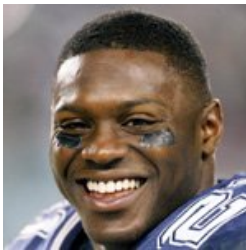
The Game Plan

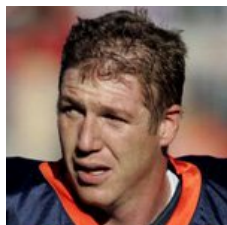
I enjoyed the film but then I'm a girl. Try it with your kids – good family entertainment.

Free Agency Update



Julius Jones - The Seahawks signed 26-year-old RB Julius Jones to a multi-year contract. Jones played for the Cowboys in all four of his NFL seasons – starting 32 consecutive games the past two years. Overall, he has started 51 of 53 career games, carrying the ball 885 times for 3,484 yards and 18 touchdowns.

TJ Duckett - Duckett comes to Seattle after spending one season in Detroit. The 27-year-old running back was originally drafted in the first round of the 2002 NFL Draft by the Atlanta Falcons where he played four seasons before being traded to the Washington Redskins in 2006. The Seahawks signed Duckett to a multi-year contract.



Jeb Putzier - The Seahawks signed the 29-year-old Putzier, a former Boise State tight end, to a one-year deal. A sixth round draft choice by the Denver Broncos in 2002, Putzier has played in 61 games with 96 receptions for 1,251 yards and 3 touchdowns in his six-year career. He played the last two seasons in Houston, including eight games in 2007 for the Texans, catching 6 balls for 39 yards and a touchdown.

Mike Wahle - The Seahawks signed 10-year veteran guard Mike Wahle to a multi-year contract. Wahle, 30, has twice made the trip to the Pro Bowl over the past three years. He started all 16 games for the Panthers last season at left guard and has started 128 of 142 games in his career. A product of the Naval Academy, Wahle was a second round (24th overall) of the 1998 Supplemental NFL Draft by the Green Bay Packers.
